

WHO WILL PROVIDE THESE SERVICES?

I am a licensed psychologist who was granted the Ph.D. degree in Educational Psychology from the University of Michigan. I received my post-doctoral clinical training at the Institute of Psychoanalytic Psychotherapy in Philadelphia.

My experience of over twenty years includes: Assistant Professor at The Pennsylvania State University (Ogontz) in Abington, Primary Therapist on an inpatient adolescent-young adult unit at Delaware Valley Mental Health Foundation in Doylestown, and more recently Clinical Psychologist with a group practice in Colmar.

I am affiliated with the following professional organizations: The American Psychological Association, the Pennsylvania Psychological Association and the Philadelphia Society of Clinical Psychologists.

WHEN MIGHT I FIND PSYCHOTHERAPY HELPFUL ?

Psychotherapy is helpful in the treatment of a broad spectrum of psychological problems. These would include disorders of thought, affect or behavior such as anxiety, depression, obsessions and compulsions, labile moods and medical conditions that may be exacerbated by psychological factors.

In other cases, you may be experiencing problems in everyday situations such as marital relationships, child-rearing, learning problems, transitional life circumstances, bereavement and family concerns.

My practice includes working with elementary age children, adolescents and adults of all ages.

I will be happy to answer any questions you may have about treatment before your initial visit.

WHAT KIND OF TREATMENT WILL BE AVAILABLE TO ME?

The modality of choice will depend upon your specific needs. My practice includes psychoanalytic psychotherapy, behavioral therapy and cognitive behavioral therapy. It is often useful to combine these strategies when working with complex issues. Treatment may be short or long-term and may be conducted in individual, couple or family sessions.

Psychiatric consultation is available as well as referral to other psychological specialties.

WILL MY DOCTOR RECEIVE A REPORT ABOUT MY TREATMENT?

Only with your written consent, will your doctor receive a report of my initial findings, your progress and completion of treatment. In addition, if you wish, I will consult with your doctor about mutual considerations in your care when appropriate.

IN THE CASE OF MY CHILD, WILL THE SCHOOL BE NOTIFIED ABOUT TREATMENT?

Only with your written consent, or if your child is eighteen years or older, with your child's written consent, will the school be notified about treatment. For example, it may be useful to your child if special programming accommodations can be implemented in order to enhance your child's learning experience.

WHAT WILL THE FEES BE FOR THESE SERVICES?

Most insurance companies will reimburse for my services as an out-of-network provider at a percent determined by the individual policy and deductible requirements. The fees are \$175 for an initial evaluation and \$150 for psychotherapy sessions.

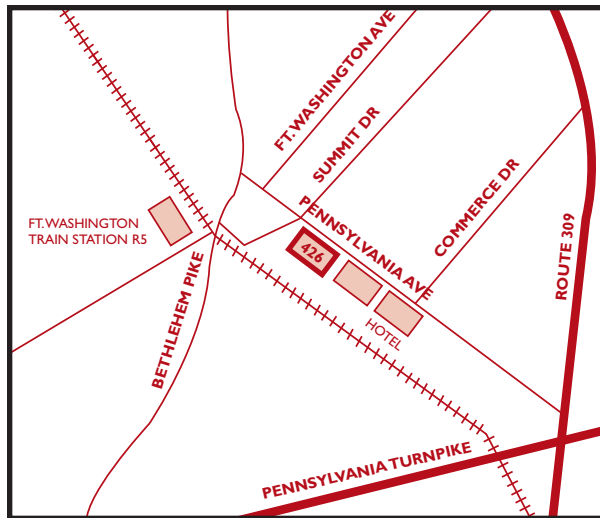
